## **BUILDING SKILLS** TO BENEFIT INDIVIDUALS

In FY21, 498 leaders participated in skill building and networking gatherings, learned about laws and regulations governing nonprofits, and strengthened their knowledge of nonprofit fundamentals. Pathways measures success not only by the number of leaders that attend our events, but more importantly, whether they learned new skills to strengthen their organizations, and have next steps identified to implement what they learned.

Results show that the more engaged and active an organization is on the Wheel, the more progress they make toward accomplishing prioritized goals to strengthen their organization.

## **CULTIVATING NETWORKS COHORTS 2011 TO PRESENT**

Pathways' cohort programs bring groups of nonprofit professionals

together based on an area of commonality such as geography, mission focus, or leadership position. Nonprofit leaders often do their best capacity-building work with their peers. Through participation in a cohort, leaders learn new management skills, organizations are supported as they become stronger, and collaborative connections are formed that can expand impact.


