A maximum of 3 registrants from an organization and three follow-up coaching hours per organization per class are available.

Workshops are FREE for participants in WNC organizations with a budget under \$50K. For all other participants, the cost is \$50 for each online course. If you would like to attend but the cost is a barrier, please don't hesitate to reach out.
