Nonprofit Fundamentals Certificate Program courses and follow-up coaching are offered to nonprofits based in and serving the 18 counties of Western North Carolina. Take advantage of FREE follow-up coaching after completion of each course. Coaching will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis and will depend on instructor availability. A maximum of 3 registrants from an organization and three follow-up coaching hours per organization per class are available. Workshops are FREE for participants in WNC organizations with a budget under \$50K. For all other participants, the cost is \$50 for <u>each</u> online course.
